

Call for INNS Award Nominations

Dear INNS members:

As you may know, INNS has an awards program, established to recognize individuals who have made outstanding contributions in the field of Neural Networks. Up to three awards, one in each of the following categories, are presented annually in the IJCNN to senior individuals for outstanding contributions made in the field of Neural Networks.

The Hebb Award - recognizes achievement in biological learning.

The Helmholtz Award - recognizes achievement in sensation/perception.

The Gabor Award - recognizes achievement in engineering/application.

In addition there is the Young Investigator Award: up to two awards are presented annually to individuals with no more than five years postdoctoral experience and who are under forty years of age, for significant contributions in the field of Neural Networks.

The INNS Awards Committee is now inviting nominations for the Hebb, Helmholtz, and Gabor awards as well as the Young Investigator awards. We need excellent candidates to maintain the prestige of the INNS Awards. We urge you to look around and think of worthy candidates.
